In today's Gospel a situation which has such a promising beginning ends up very badly. The gesture of forgiveness by the king at the beginning does not succeed in inspiring a more compassionate behaviour in his subordinates. The forgiven servant does not know how to forgive his fellow servant. The other servants do not forgive him his heartlessness and ask the king to do justice. The enraged king withdraws his pardon and hands the servant over to be punished.

At times we naively believe that the world would be more human if everything were governed by order, strict justice and punishment for those who behave badly. The denial of forgiveness seems quite normal and even honourable for an offence, a humiliation or an injustice. However, that is not what will humanise the world. A couple without mutual understanding would destroy each other. A family without forgiveness would be a hell. A society without compassion would be inhuman. What would become of us if *God* did not know how to forgive?

In the parable we think that the servant forgiven by the king ought to forgive his fellow servant. It is the *least* we would require of him. But then isn't forgiveness the *least* to be expected of us - we who live sustained by the pardon and mercy of God. We speak of forgiveness as an admirable and heroic deed, but for Jesus it is quite normal. Should it not be likewise for us?
